The contract promised that my Mustang would be displayed on twenty different car sites. After several months it was taken off line and not put back, after multiple requests. When I went to the first twelve “car websites”, I found that it was only listed on four and the sites were so obscure that you would have to spend a long time to locate my car. After contacting the BBB, I still haven’t received any feedback as to an action taken against the company. It seems that Timeless Auto Sales is aka Class Cars Connect. So, learn from me and do not use the above-mentioned crooks.
